Crime update

July saw a spate of four burglaries between 9th and 12th, however targeted patrols seems to have put an end to this. There were two others burglaries, one on 5th and one on 20th July. Apart from the targeted patrols, a Smartwater event was held on 28th July at the Co-Op involving the Police Beat Team included the Police Volunteers. The event was very successful with sixty Smartwater packages sold in a four hour period.

After last months catalytic converters thefts there were none this month. The Beat Team including Police Volunteers had been active in putting leaflets through addresses where there was 4x4 type vehicles identified.

There were ten non recordable reports during the month. These were made up of three domestic incidents, two harassments and five Vulnerable Persons reports.
