#### **Crime Update**

November saw theft from vehicles occur where owners had left valuables such as laptops, handbags and sat-navs in the vehicle and on a number of occasions left their vehicles unlocked. This is entirely avoidable so we urge people to spend the extra minute or so to take your valuables with you when you lock your car in order to avoid becoming a victim.

Four people were arrested following a handful of theft from vehicle offences in Glenfield, as well as other offences in the City area. These people have been released on Police bail whilst further enquiries are carried out.

### **Crime Prevention Advice**

In the run up to Christmas we need to be on our guard against burglars that will take the opportunity to steal the extra gifts and valuables that we have in our homes at this time of year. Please don't leave presents and gifts, or any other valuable items, in full view of windows and always ensure you lock your doors, even when at home. There's no better present for a burglar than an unlocked door and expensive items still in their boxes just inside!

The simple method of using lights on timers is one of the best ways of discouraging burglars. The chances are that if they think there is someone at home, they won't risk trying to break in. Timers can be bought from most hardware and similar shops for little expense and are well worth the money.
