Positive Outcomes from Crime

December saw a reduction in crime overall this month. With the incidents of Theft from Motor Vehicles more than halved. Throughout the year Beat 55 (Kirby Muxloe, Leicester Forest East and Glenfield) has seen an overall reduction in reported crime which is a great result. Three suspects have been arrested in connection with Theft from Motor Vehicles in Leicester Forest East, enquires are still on going.

Emerging Crime Trends and Crime Prevention

Towards the end of December we have seen an increase in Burglary and Burglary Other than Dwelling with pedal cycles being targeted in these crimes. Please can you ensure that you have secured your pedal cycles, even if they are kept in a secure garage.

Anti-Social Behavior

Just 11 reports were taken for ASB in December which is a significant decrease, especially compared to last year. On a whole ASB has seen a reduction over the year. The beat team continue to complete Op Antidote patrols and work on our Problem Solving Plan which tackles ASB in and around the David Wilson Estate.
