Crime Update

December saw a rise in vehicle crime, with the majority of offences being valuable items stolen from people's cars. These were mainly overnight offences whilst vehicles were parked on driveways. As we have said before, this is entirely avoidable so we urge people to spend the extra minute or so to take your valuables with you when you lock your car in order to avoid becoming a victim.

Crime Prevention Advice

The number of burglaries over the festive season was not as high as it has been traditionally across the area. We hope that this is as a result of people taking heed of our advice in terms of home security. Lights on timers are still one of the most effective ways to discourage the would-be burglar when you are not at home. Ensure you lock your doors and windows to avoid being the easy target. Smartwater still is one of the best ways to deter criminals and to ensure you are reunited with your property should it be stolen and subsequently recovered by the Police.

Anti-Social Behaviour

December saw only one recorded incident of anti-social behaviour. This related to some cars racing around the area of The Brantings.
